



Mr David J. Kolleda is a native of Pittsburgh PA, and a 1982 graduate from the Indiana University of Pennsylvania, where he received his commission into the Transportation Corps as a Distinguished Military Graduate. Mr Kolleda retired from active military service as a Colonel in 2008.
