## I. First Quarter (1 Jan - 31 Mar 65)

1. On 15 Jan First Lt Ronald Bodziony was assigned to the unit. ON 13 Feb Lt Bodziony was reassigned to the 597th Trans Co (MTrk).

2. The unit satisfactorily completed a commo check of Alert Recall Plan on 25 Jan and successfully completed and Assembly Test Exercise on 27 January.

3. On 8 February the unit was awarded the Peninsula United Fund Plaque for 100 % participation in charitable contributions.

4. The unit's Mess was designated Best Mess by the 48th Trans Group on 1 March.

5. On 2 -3 March the annual AGI inspection was conducted and the unit received a satisfactory rating.

6. 2nd Lt Michael M Wilson was assigned to the unit and was made Platoon Leader of the 2nd Platoon on 16 March.

## II. Second Quarter (1 Apr - 30 Jun 65)

1. On 2 April the unit returned from a 3 day commitment at Camp A F Hill, Virginia, where it acted in direct support of the USAT School Basic Officer's Course field exercise. Outstanding compliments were received by the company.

2. 2nd Lt Gary K Ludwig was assigned to the unit on 17 May.

3. 2nd Lt Michael M Wilson was reassigned to the 62nd Trans Co, Ft Eustis, Virginia, on 19 May.

4. The unit received its annual Command Material Maintenance Inspection on 24 - 25 May and received an overall rating of satisfactory.

5. On 31 May CWO W2 Earl Herman departed the unit and was transferred to USA (Ret) after more than 20 years of active service.

6. Captain Wayne A Tritaik assumed command of the unit on 1 June to replace Captain Harold E Grady who was transferred to the 27th Trans Bn, Ft Eustis, Virginia.

### III. Third Quarter (1 Jul - 30 Sep 65)

1. On 11 August the unit was released from USATCFE Ft Eustis, Virginia, and the Second US Army and reassigned to USARPAC.

2. The unit departed Ft Eustis, Virginia, destined for Oakland, California, on 13 August. On 16 August unit arrived at the Oakland Army Terminal and boarded the USNS Gen W H Gordon troop ship.

3. On 17 August the unit left Oakland, California destined for Viet Nam.

4. The unit arrived at Qui Nhon, Viet Nam on 2 September but did not debark ship.

5. On 6 September the unit left Qui Nhon destined for Cam Ranh Bay, arriving there on 7 September.

6. The unit was attached for all purposes to the Provisional Battalion, Cam Ranh Bay Fort Area, APO US Forces 96312, on 7 September.

7. On 21 September the unit was detached from the Provisional Bn and attached for all purposes to the 10th Transportation Battalion (Tml).

8. On 25 September the IG of the 1st Logistical Command visited the company area.

### IV. Fourth Quarter (1 Oct - 31 Dec 65)

1. 1st Lt Philip A Limpert, Jr joined the unit on 15 October as the Platoon Leader of the 3rd Platoon replacing 1st Lt Robert G Haid who was reassigned to the 10th Trans Bn (Tml) to become the Adjutant of the 10th Trans Bn (Tml).

2. On 29 December the 1st Logistical Command Inspection team inspected the unit Motor Pool. Unit received a very satisfactory rating.
