1. The annual General Inspection was held on 1 December 1966. The unit received an overall rating of Excellent.
2. The unit attended ANACDUTRA at Camp Pickett, Virginia from 2 July 1966 to 16 July 1966 with a site support and training mission. The US CONARC Form 151 rating was Satisfactory. It was necessary for the unit to train 62 recruits in basic training subjects because Active Army training Centers were unable to absorb them for six month enlistments prior to summer encampment.
3. The unit began conducting four (4) hour assemblies effective 1 October 1966. Multiple assemblies remained at eight hours.
4. The Annual CMMI was held on 14 September 1966. The unit received a rating of Satisfactory.
5. The unit was reorganized per paragraph 1, Section 1, GO 29, Hqs, XXI USA Corps dated 28 January 1966 to be effective 31 January 1966.
6. DAVID B. EHLE, [REDACTED], 1 Lt, assumed command of the 630th Transportation Company effective 21 March 1966.
7. Captain Ralph G. Hatfield retired on 22 March 1966 after completing 23 years service with the US Army and US Army Reserve. Captain Hatfield served as Commanding Officer of the 630th Transportation Company from 14 July 1963 until his retirement.
